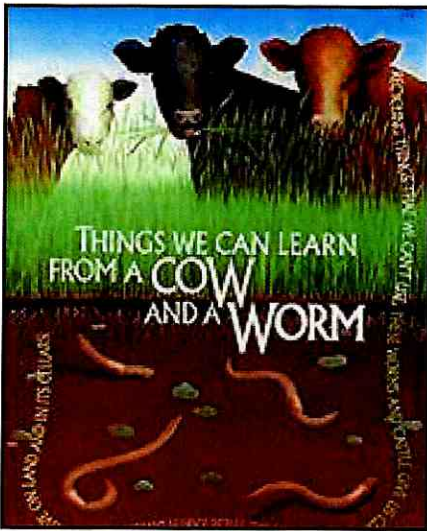
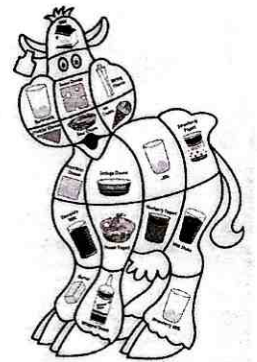

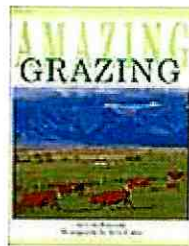


Hands-On Teacher's Guide for Crop Kit

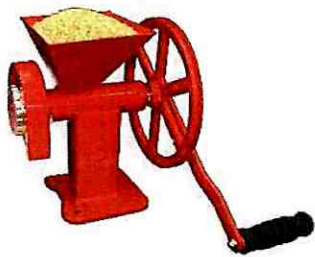
